

2009-2010 GGC of Oregon Dress Code

The following is the official dress code for both Daughters and adults for the 2008-2009 Grand Guardian Council year. Proper attire is the responsibility of each Bethel and should be discussed and addressed.

Please remember that when you are representing Job's Daughters, it is then that our Order is in the spotlight.

Appropriate behavior and proper attire will display a positive image for Job's Daughters. This applies to both Daughters and adults!

General Guidelines:

Flip-Flop: A backless, often foam rubber sandal held to the foot at the big toe by means of a "thong."

- ☞ If your flip-flop has a heel (not the sole) of ½" or more and/or has decorative fixtures, it may be worn as a sandal with dresses.
- ☞ If your nails, hair color, make-up, piercings, etc are more noticeable than your beautiful personality and moral character, you are only doing yourself and Job's Daughters a disservice. Be proud of yourself and your membership in this organization.

Casual:

- ☞ Sport or nice casual wear, flip-flops are ok
- ☞ No spaghetti strap t-shirts or midriff shirts (your middle should be covered)
- ☞ No "short" shorts and no tattered jeans or cut-offs



Swim Wear:



Swimsuits should be worn with the following guidelines:

- ☞ No string or thong pieces
- ☞ Your body should be covered in appropriate places (no bare midriffs)
- ☞ Cover-ups are required going to and from the pool area, for all Daughters and adults
- ☞ If your "tankini" keeps your middle covered it is ok to wear

Meeting Attire:

- ☞ Dresses or skirt with nice shirt for women and Daughters, flip-flops: see above
- ☞ Skirt length should not be higher than 3 inches above the knee
- ☞ Dress pants and shirts for men. Jackets and ties are recommended, but optional.
- ☞ No casual t-shirts (look-a-likes ok), tank tops or midriff shirts – applicable to everyone



Formal Attire:

- ☞ Tea-length (mid-calf) or long formal dresses (spaghetti strap and strapless dresses are ok) for women and Daughters with appropriate undergarments and accessories
- ☞ Always remember good taste, no low cut dresses (no cleavage), no low backs, and slits in the skirt should not be higher than 3 inches above the knee
- ☞ Tuxes, dinner suits or coats and ties for men
- ☞ No flip-flops or tennis shoes with formals or tuxes



Official Bethel Regalia for Daughters:

- ☞ Clean and pressed robes with a **long** slip (please, don't forget the slip...4"-6" from the floor)
- ☞ Appropriate **white** undergarments, not visible through your robe
- ☞ Clean stockings, clean shoes, headband or crown and cape
- ☞ Jewelry may be worn in accordance with the Manual of Rules and Regulations (B-Bethel 5, Article VI, Section 2, (b) No jewelry shall be worn with a Bethel robe except a Job's Daughters' ring, watch or other ring, Grand Bethel and/or Supreme Bethel Medallion.)
- ☞ A neat and conservative appearance is always the most attractive. Tattoos should not be visible and piercing retainers are recommended for facial piercings.
