## Letter of Reference Request

As part of this year's pageant, we are asking each contestant to submit TWO letters of reference.

One should be from someone within the Job's Daughter community: someone from your Bethel, lodge, or other adult who knows you well and can sing your praises about your Job's Daughter world!

The second needs to be from someone OUTSIDE the Job's Daughter world. It could be a teacher, a neighbor, a family friend, just someone who can tell us about your life outside of Job's Daughters.

These don't need to be long, and do not need to include all your accomplishments. One to two pages will be enough, focusing on how you are an example of the qualities that make a great Job's Daughter: leadership, friendship, participation, etc. Remember, even though they love you, immediate family are NOT eligible as references.
