Dear Oregon Job's Daughters,

Last year much work was done in reorganizing our Grand Bethel program in order to serve this generation of Job's Daughters. Through the work of the Jobie Evolution Team and your hard work at the Congress meetings last year, you approved the new Grand Bethel Rules and Regulations and Standing Rules and well as the Miss Oregon Rules and Regulations. So for the first time in Oregon we will have a progressive line where the Grand Bethel Senior Princess is eligible to be elected up to Grand Bethel Honored Queen. Changing our leadership to have this two year commitment was done to give Daughters a year to grow and prepare, make better plans for the year, and to establish their working relationships for success. Elections this year will be held at Grand Bethel Weekend April 16, 2011. And so it is time for each girl who is eligible, to "DARE TO BE REMARKABLE", and to submit her application to be a Grand Bethel Senior Princess Candidate. Being a leader in the Oregon Grand Bethel is a perfect opportunity to grow as a speaker and leader; learn about yourself and others; meet new people and travel; and be a role model and mentor to the other young leaders in our state. This is your time to make a difference!

Attached are the necessary forms to make application to become a Grand Bethel Senior Princess candidate. **All application forms must reach the Youth Committee Chair by March 31, 2011.**

The guidelines for eligibility, application, and selection are as follows:

Eligibility

- (a) A special group will be called "Grand Bethel Senior Princess Candidates." The Job's Daughters eligible are current spring term Honored Queens and/or any Past Honored Queens who are members in good standing, who have been in regular attendance for a period of six (6) months in the Bethel to be represented, unless excused by the Bethel Guardian. The Grand Bethel Senior Princess candidates shall be at least fifteen (15) and not yet nineteen (19) years of age at the time of the first official business day of the Annual Session of the Grand Guardian Council.

Application

- (a) Each applicant will submit an application on the forms approved by the Youth Committee. The forms shall include: Applicant's Basic Information including name, age, address, birth date, Bethel number and city; Job's Daughter Resume including offices held and other important information; Bethel Guardian Secretary's Verification; Statement of Parental support with parent or legal guardian's consent in supporting and approving her application; and Confidential Recommendation Form.
- (b) Applicant will submit forms A and B. The Bethel Guardian Secretary of the applicant's Bethel will submit form C. Applicant's parent(s) will submit form D. The applicant will ensure the

Recommendation Form E is duplicated and handed out to ALL Bethel Members and Bethel Guardian Council members present at a February or March Bethel meeting. Recommendation Form E may be emailed to any Bethel Member or Bethel Guardian Council member not present at the designated Bethel meeting. Recommenders will submit Form E. Recommendations will be kept confidential. All forms may be submitted by mail or emailed. All forms must reach the Youth Committee Chair by March 31, 2011.

- (c) The Youth Committee Chair shall send an acknowledgment to each applicant upon receipt of her completed application.
- (d) The Youth Committee shall review all applications and recommendations for completeness and support. If the applicant does not have support from the parents, Daughters, Bethel Guardian Council and/or Bethel Deputy, the Youth Committee may reject the application.
- (e) The Youth Committee Chair shall notify the Daughter whether she will or will not be a Grand Bethel Senior Princess candidate no later than April 5, 2011.
- (f) The Grand Bethel Senior Princess applicants will take an open book Ritual test to assess their knowledge. This test will be given on April 2, 2011 at 12 noon at the Friendship Masonic Lodge preceding the Masonic Heritage Day. The test is a tool to help gauge where the daughter is in her ritual readiness and will not affect her ability to be a candidate or not.

Attached is the Grand Bethel Honored Queen contract. This contract outlines the duties and responsibilities of the Grand Bethel Honored Queen and should be reviewed by the Daughter and her parents prior to submitting for candidacy. The daughter upon election will need to agree to the terms set forth in the contract and it will need to be signed by both the daughter and her parent (s) prior to installation.
