The time has come to submit your application for an Oregon Job's Daughters scholarship. Scholarships in the amount of \$750.00 will be awarded to deserving Daughters who submit their completed application packets prior to the deadline of April 1, 2011.

The educational purpose shall be interpreted to cover any form of finishing education whether it be business/vocational training or completion of an education in a chosen field.

Awards are based on the following criteria:

- Recommendation of Executive members of the Bethel Guardian Council.

To apply for a scholarship award, a Daughter may request an application packet from the Educational Scholarship Committee Chairman. 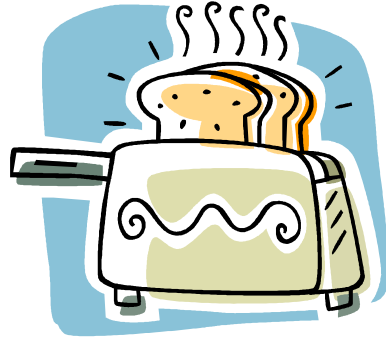
There will be no fee required to obtain an application packet.

2011 Oregon Rose Award

In an effort to find a way to honor those special adult workers who give extra effort and time to help their Bethel and Oregon Job's Daughters prosper, the Executive Grand Guardian Council created the Oregon Rose Award. Current Executive Grand Guardian Council officers are not eligible for nomination for this award.

The Oregon Rose Award is unique to our jurisdiction. Anyone may submit a nomination for this award and the nominee can be a man or a woman. A nomination requires at least one letter of recommendation along with the nomination form. This doesn't mean you have to stop at one letter or at one nominee. The nomination form is posted on the www.oriojd.org website on the "AWARDS" button.

The Executive Grand Guardian Council will meet in June and will make final selections. Recipients will be kept secret until the presentation at Grand Session.

There is no requirement for the recipients to have been a Bethel Guardian or Associate Guardian. In fact, they don't have to have been on a Bethel Council at all! Any adult who supported a Bethel, the Grand Guardian Council or the Order with exceptional service and dedication (above and beyond what would be considered usual service) may be nominated.
