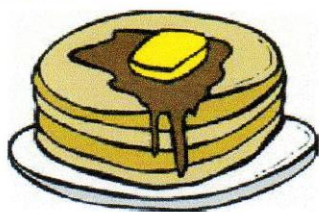

The prices range from \$18 up to \$30 depending on what you would like.

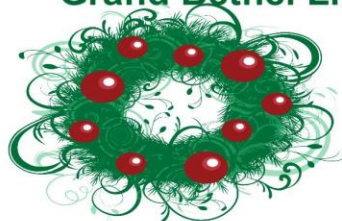
If you would like to have a wreath sent directly to you or to someone else there is an additional cost of \$12

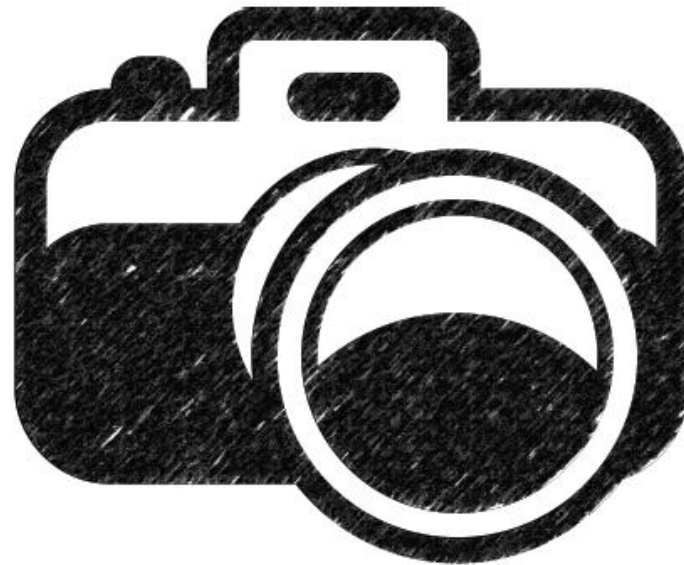
