BOOT CAMP PACKING LIST

BE PREPARED FOR RAIN.

Girls will have to walk from cabins to lodge so will at times be in the rain. Camp is rugged so there will be mud and we will still be having some outside activities.

Medical release form (to stay with adult chaperones)

Ritual

Pen/paper or notebook (a folder will be provided)

Medications/ Inhaler

Camera (optional)

Sleeping bag or sheets and heavy blankets (single bunks)

Pillow (extra blanket-optional)

Boots, tennis shoes, or closed toe shoes (more than one pair in case one gets muddy or wet)

Shower items-towel, shampoo, soap (1 shower per 10 campers)

Hair/skin care items- brush, hair ties, lotion, etc.

Sanitary Napkin items

There will be a camp nurse with band aids etc.

Any camouflage or military wear is encouraged (for fun to go with Boot Camp theme!)

Jeans (if girls are wearing light cotton pants or stretchy pants make sure they will be warm enough)

Sweatshirt or flannel shirt

1 t-shirt will be provided for Sat wear

Other short or long sleeve t-shirts

Bra, underwear

Socks and EXTRA socks (for warmth and if they get wet)

Jacket needed as it gets cool at night

Rainwear

Scarf/Hat

If warm- Shorts, hat, sunscreen

NO NEED FOR- Ipods/music, cell phone use (except for emergencies)

Girls should not be texting, checking internet or using phone during any lesson or meal times. Calls to parents are allowed. Bethel Chaperones will monitor cell phone issues.

Directions to Camp Adams

From I-5 South

- Take I-5 to the Woodburn exit 271 and turn east (left). This is Highway 214.
- Stay on 214 through Woodburn; it becomes Highway 211 as it crosses 99E.
- Follow 211 past Molalla 3 miles to the 4 way stop where the highway curves to the right.
- Follow on 211 about 3 miles to Camp Adams which is located between mile markers 18 and 19, $\frac{3}{4}$ mile past marker 18, on the left side of the highway.

From I-5 North

- Take I-5 to 205 north.
- Take exit 10 off 205, turn south (right) on Highway 213.
- Continue south past Mulino about 1 mile to the Union Mills road turnoff; you can only turn left.
- Continue 4 miles to the 4-way stop.
- Go straight through the intersection—you are now on Highway 211
- Drive about 3 miles to Camp Adams, located on the left side of the highway.
- The camp is located between mile markers 18 and 19, $\frac{3}{4}$ mile past marker 18.

From I-84 East

- Take I-84 West to the I-205 south exit.
- Take exit 10 off 205 and turn south (left) on Highway 213.
- Continue south past Mulino about 1 mile to the Union Mills road turnoff; you can only turn left.
- Continue 4 miles to the 4-way stop.
- Go straight through the intersection—you are now on Highway 211—and drive about 3 miles to Camp Adams, located on the left side of the highway.
- The camp is located between mile markers 18 and 19, $\frac{3}{4}$ mile past marker 18.
